When: from 9 April to 9 May 2016

Schedule: <u>April 9 (first day)</u>: from 8 am to 5 pm

April 10 to May 8: from 9 am to 5 pm

#### May 9 (last day): from 9 am to 6 pm

The Embassy will <u>not</u> entertain consular applications during weekends (Saturday and Sunday).

The Embassy remains open for consular transactions during weekdays (Monday – Friday) from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. (no lunch break).

## WHAT TO BRING

If your name is included in the CLOV, please bring any of your valid Philippine ID with photo (e.g. passport).

You are strongly encouraged to bring your "kodigo" containing the list of your preferred candidates.

Please wear decent attire.

### **STEPS IN VOTING**

1. Registered voter presents valid ID with photo to the Poll Clerk.

2. Once identity is verified, the voter will be directed to the Chair to receive his/her ballot.

3. Chair will give ballot to voter after completion of prescribed procedures.

4. Voter to properly fill out the ballot in the designated voting area.

5. Voter to return to the SBEI and drop the accomplished ballot inside the ballot box.

# WHO TO VOTE

**Do not overvote**. Your ballot should only contain a maximum of:

1 President 1 Vice President 12 Senators 1 Party List Group

The profile of the candidates are available for viewing or downloading at the COMELEC website (<u>www.comelec.gov.ph</u>).

### **OTHER REMINDERS**

Voters are strongly encouraged to **vote as** early as possible to avoid the crowd.

The Embassy strictly maintains its **neutrality** in the forthcoming elections thus its premises cannot be utilized for partisan political activities for any candidate.
